TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

BEERLINE CLEANER with PURPLE INDICATOR

Specifically designed for beerline cleaning, this advanced formulation helps to keep beer lines clean and sanitised in just one operation. This product incorporates the latest technology by changing colour once the beer apparatus is clean, thus maintaining the quality of the beer. This is an intelligent product that changes colour if the beerline is dirty. When the detergent initially goes in the line the product is purple. If the liquid comes out discoloured at all you know the line is dirty. However once the detergent turns to purple again you know all yeast deposits and bacteria are removed. Due to its distinctive purple colour there is less likelihood of accidental ingestion if the lines are not rinsed. This product is based on Potassium Hydroxide and is therefore Caustic soda free.

- ◆ Colour changing liquid depending upon cleanliness of the beer lines
- ◆ Cleans, sterilises and maintains beer lines, pipes, pumps, engines, taps & fittings
- ◆ Effectively removes all yeast deposits, bacteria and dirt

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

- ◆ Create a solution of 1:100-1:50 depending on the hardness of the water
- ◆ Prepare the solution in a clean bucket
- ◆ Draw the solution through to the dispense tap. Let stand for 5 minutes
- ◆ Draw off the solution into a separate clean bucket and check the colour. If the colour is not purple repeat this process until it is
- ◆ Important: when the above process is completed the lines must be flushed thoroughly with water until no colour is evident

STORAGE:

Store in original container and protect from extremes of temperature. Do not store in direct sunlight nor allow the product to freeze. Shelf life (in unopened original container) is a minimum of 18 months.
